What radio stations are in the Solomon Islands?

International dial code: +677 International Domestic Radio broadcast stations: AM 1, FM 4 Paoa FM, ZFM100, Wan FM, and Barava FM, shortwave 1 (2002). The Solomon Islands Broadcasting Corporation, founded in 1976, transmits regular programming.

Why is Internet not available in Solomon Islands?

Internet access remains unaffordable for most Solomon Islanders due to the country's total dependence on costly, limited satellite connectivity, and the lack of competition. For this reason the future availability and affordability of mobile data services will be vital to the growth of broadband internet in Solomon Islands.

Does Solomon Islands have a telecommunication policy?

Although a World Trade Organization member, Solomon Islands has made no telecommunication commitments under the General Agreement on Trade in Services.

Is BeMobile an ISP in Solomon Islands?

Until 2011, STCL was the only licensed internet service provider (ISP) in Solomon Islands. BeMobile is in effect already an ISP since under the terms of its license it can offer mobile data services.

How affordable is Internet access in Solomon Island?

While tariffs in absolute terms are now comparable to those of neighbouring countries, in terms of affordability they remain relatively high. Internet access remains unaffordable for most Solomon Islanders due to the country's total dependence on costly, limited satellite connectivity, and the lack of competition.

When did Solomon Island become a telecom Commissioner?

Solomon Island's first Telecom Commissioner took office in January 2010. As part of its reform process, in September 2011, following public consultation the TCSI brought into effect a 6 EDGE stands for Enhanced Data rates for GSM Evolution, and high-speed 3G technology that was built on the GSM standard. Communications.
