What type of power plugs are used in the Cook Islands?

On the Cook Islands, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type I are used. The standard voltage is 240 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Do I need a power adapter in Cook Islands?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Cook Islands, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer.

What type of power sockets are on the Cook Islands?

The power sockets on the Cook Islands are of type I. The standard voltage is 240 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter on the Cook Islands.

Can a universal power adapter fit a Cook Islands outlet?

Universal power adapters usually come with multiple plug types and can be adjusted to fit Cook Islands outlets and many others. If your devices are not compatible with the voltage in your destination country, a voltage converter or transformer will also be necessary to convert the voltage to the appropriate range for your devices.

What voltage does the Cook Islands use?

The Cook Islands utilize a standard voltage of 240 volts and a frequency of 50 Hz. The country primarily uses plug type I, which is a three-pin plug with a grounded pin in the center and two flat pins on either side. This plug type is also commonly found in Australia, New Zealand, and other countries in the region.
