Who controls imports into Ireland?

Revenue responsible for controlling imports into Ireland for customs purposes and on behalf of other government departments. All goods imported into Ireland must be declared to Revenue in advance of arrival. Among other things, customs officers make sure that any goods declared for import are moving legally and are not prohibited or restricted.

How do I clear customs for imported goods in Ireland?

The process of clearing customs for imported goods is as follows: First, check if the goods you are importing are permitted in Ireland. Declare your goods through a customs declaration (Made electronically using the Automated Import System (AIS) and which accompanies all regulated goods).

Which countries have laws on prohibited and restricted imports in Ireland?

What documents do I need to import goods into Ireland?

Include your import license to demonstrate you are legally allowed to bring certain goods into Ireland. Ensure that the exact amount due in duties and taxes is paid upfront to speed up the process of customs clearance. The following documents are required to export goods:
