Who is the largest gas producer in Libya?

Eni is the leading international gas producer in Libya, with a share of 80% of the national production (1.6 bscfd in 2022). The company has been operating in Libya since 1959 and currently has a large portfolio of assets in exploration, production and development.

Who will attend the Libya Energy & Economic Summit?

How many gas fields are there in Libya?

It consists of the development of two gas fields, namely Structures "A" and "E", located in the contractual area D, offshore Libya. The combined gas production from the two structures will start in 2026 and reach a plateau of 750 million of standard gas cubic feet per day.

What are Eni's upcoming 2025 plans for Libya?

In an exclusive interview with Energy Capital and Power, Luca Vignati, Eni's Upstream Director, discusses the company's upcoming 2025 plans for Libya, which involve offshore drilling for the Structures A&E project, an ultra-deepwater well in Area C, and seismic acquisition in the Sirte Basin.

What's going on with Eni in Libya?

Following an agreement signed in December 2023 with the International Organization for Migration, a five-year cooperation project is underway to train 850 young people facilitating access to work. Eni has resumed onshore exploration activities in Libya after a 10-year hiatus, starting with the A1-96/3 well in the Ghadames Basin.

Who signed a gas agreement in Libya?

The agreement was signed in the presence of Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni and Libyan Government of National Unity Prime Minister Abdul Hamid Al-Dbeibah.
