How much does electricity cost in France?

The chart below displays the hourly electricity prices for France. France is 7.02 cents per kilowatt-hour(kWh). The pricing information displayed is sourced from ENTSO-E - the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Electricity. All prices are originally in Central European Time (CET/CEST).

How much electricity did France produce in 2024?

In 2024, French electricity output reached a five-year high of 536.5 TWh, of which 67% (361.7 TWh) was produced by nuclear reactors. This marked a strong rebound for nuclear generation after two years of unusually low output (due to extended maintenance and technical issues).
