Is East Timor interested in solar power?

East Timor President Jos#233; Ramos-Horta told The Associated Press in an interview in Dili last week that his country is interested in exploring various types of renewable energy sources, including wind, sea and especially solar power. "We have plenty of sun," he said, adding that the cost of solar technology continues to fall.

Why should Timor-Leste invest in solar & storage infrastructure?

Jos#233; added: "The investment in Timor-Leste's solar and storage infrastructure is transformative. It will help reduce dependence on fossil fuels while improving grid stability and energy access across the country". Does East Timor have electricity?

Access to electricity is a modern development for many of East Timor's 1.3 million people, after much of the country's infrastructure was razed by Indonesian forces during the war for independence. Recovery was slow after East Timor gained formal independence in 2002.

Does Timor-Leste rely on diesel fuel?
