



Georgia pulls solar photovoltaic panels

Can you put solar panels on a property in Georgia?

Having solar panels on a property disqualifies someone from getting a tax break under the assessment, but law currently lets Georgia landowners put solar panels on a portion of the property, without fully violating the statute, and still get a tax break. If HB 169 was passed, residents no longer would have that option.

What happens if a solar power facility throws away solar panels?

The bill says if a solar power facility throws away solar panels instead of recycling them, they can be fined up to \$1,000 per offense, and that the attorney general or a district attorney can sue to collect the fine. State Rep. Trey Kelley (R-16) was the primary sponsor of the bill, but he couldn't be reached for comment.

How many PPAs are there in Georgia?

The five PPAs were selected by Georgia Power following a competitive solicitation overseen by an independent evaluator and PSC staff. The facilities will be located throughout Georgia and include: Mitchell County: A 25-year PPA providing 260 MW of solar capacity. Coffee County: A 30-year PPA providing 200 MW of solar capacity.
