



Ghana's major energy storage plants

What type of energy does Ghana use?

Ghana's thermal power generation is fueled largely by natural gas, but occasionally uses light crude oil and diesel. Ghana exports power to Togo, Benin, and Burkina Faso. The Government of Ghana remains heavily involved in the energy sector, with state entities having a controlling presence in the value chain.

What are the main sources of power in Ghana?

Overview of The Ghana Power Sector Ghana's power supply sources are from hydroelectricity, thermal fueled by crude oil, natural gas and diesel, solar and also imports from La Cote D'Ivoire. Ghana also exports power to Togo, Benin and Burkina Faso. Ongoing grid expansions would allow further exports to other neighboring countries in the sub region.

What are the three main sectors of electricity in Ghana?

There are three primary segments in the electricity sector: generation, transmission and distribution. Ghana's power suppliers are completely state-owned. Since the government controls both transmission and generation of power across the country, it has the authority to set power prices that consumers must pay.

Why is the energy sector a problem in Ghana?

Long delays in payments to power producers are a significant concern in the sector as the government pays for the subsidy from the national budget. Debt within the energy sector, coupled with the high cost of power in Ghana, creates a brake on Ghana's economic development.

What percentage of Ghana's Electricity comes from hydro & renewables?

In 2021, hydro accounted for around 34.1% of total power, with thermal accounting for 65.3% and renewables accounting for 0.55%. according to USAID. Ghana Grid Company (GRIDCo) is responsible for all transmissions. Distribution Company (NEDCo) and Enclave Power Company (EPC).

What is Ghana's energy mix?

Ghana's energy generation mix has primarily consisted of hydro and thermal sources. In 2021, hydro accounted for around 34.1% of total power, with thermal accounting for 65.3% and renewables accounting for 0.55%. according to USAID. Ghana Grid Company (GRIDCo) is responsible for all transmissions.
