

# How many 5G base stations are there in Mongolia

Does Mongolia have a 5G network?

Unitel Group, identified as Mongolia's largest data network provider, is already activating 5G base stations in these regions. Regulatory approvals permit operators to extend deployment in phases, addressing Mongolia's unique geographic challenges.

How many 5G base stations are there in China?

Xie Cun, director of the information and communication development department at the ministry, said that Chinese operators have already deployed more than 1.15 million 5G base stations, accounting for more than 70% of the global total, and 5G network coverage has been achieved in urban areas of all prefecture-level cities.

How much does 5G cost in Mongolia?

According to research, 5G technology is estimated to account for 1-4 percent of Mongolia's GDP by 2030, creating an economic growth of MNT 800 billion annually." In Mongolia, 1GB of data costs an average of USD 0.6, which is cheaper than the world average of USD 4.2.

Which country has the first 5G network?

South Korea is the country which deployed the first 5G network and is expected to stay in the lead as far as penetration of the technology goes. By 2025, almost 60 percent of mobile subscriptions in South Korea are expected to be for 5G networks.

Which countries are implementing 5G?

The Americas and Europe are on the forefront of 5G implementation, as our map shows. But investments in the technology have also been made in almost every country in Asia, with the technology also already deployed in many Asian countries.

Will Mongolia reach 70% 5G coverage by 2027?

Mongolia aims to reach 70% 5G population coverage by 2027. The TRC and relevant ministries will oversee progress and ensure operators meet technical and coverage benchmarks, forming a critical part of the nation's digital transformation agenda.
