How much do solar panels cost?

The price of solar panels changes depending on where you live, but the average for installation is just under \$29,000 or \$2.75 per watt. On the high end, we talked to a solar customer in Hawaii who spent \$100,000 going solar. Dion in Nevada said their 10-kW system cost about \$20,000, which is about the national average price for a 7-kW system.

How much does a CPV solar system cost?

Concentrated photovoltaic (CPV) panels are \$0.80 to \$1.10 per watt. While not as well-known as other types of panels, CPV panels are highly efficient and may grow in popularity. A 6 kW solar system would cost \$4,800 to \$6,600. A single solar cell costs about \$0.30 and most panels use 60 or 72 cells. The more cells in a panel, the higher the cost.

How much does a solar system cost per watt?

As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84. Most solar companies set the price according to the solar system's wattage. A solar installation's "cost per watt" is a little like the "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes.

How much does a commercial solar system cost?

Costs vary by region, installer, and complexity. For commercial buildings, solar panels average \$2.00 per watt, with a 100 kW system potentially offsetting the entire electricity bill. The initial cost for commercial solar setups is around \$200,000 before incentives.

Are solar panels expensive?

No, solar panels in the USA are not considered expensive. On average, a 6.6 kW solar panel system typically costs around \$16,000, not considering government incentives and rebates. Solar panel costs in the US usually range from \$4,500 to \$36,000, or \$1.00-\$3.60 per watt (W).

How much do solar panels cost in 2025?

One of the biggest barriers to installing solar panels is the significant upfront cost. In 2025, the average price of a solar installation is about \$21,816 before any incentives are applied. While this \$3.03 per-watt price tag is lower than solar panels have cost in the past, it's still a significant upfront investment.

Today, the price of solar panels for a home is currently averaging \$3-5 per watt, depending on the state you live in the size of your PV system and other factors mentioned above. Efficiency ...
