How much oil does Syria export a day?

Syria exported 380,000 barrels of oil per day (bpd) in 2010, a year before protests against Bashar al-Assad's rule spiralled into a nearly 14-year war that devastated the country's economy and infrastructure - including crude production. How much does Syria export a year?

Year over year, the value of Syria's exported products retreated by -34.2% compared to \$1.25 billion starting from 2023. The 5 biggest exports from the Syrian Arab Republic are olive oil, uncombed cotton, miscellaneous nuts, natural calcium phosphates, then ginger, saffron and other spices.

What products are exported from Syria?

The 5 biggest exports from the Syrian Arab Republic are olive oil, uncombed cotton, miscellaneous nuts, natural calcium phosphates, then ginger, saffron and other spices. Combined, those 5 leading product categories accounted for almost three-fifths (57.5%) of the value of all Syrian exported products in 2024.

The US Energy Information Administration (EIA) estimated in 2015 that Syria possessed 2.5 billion barrels of proved oil reserves. 5 Syria's crude is heavy and sour. 6 In 2010, Syria produced 383,000 barrels per day of oil. 7

How much money does Syria export in 2023?

Disclaimer: data is presented based on availability and only countries that use the harmonized system are being shown. In 2023, Syria exported a total of \$1.27B, making it the number 152 exporter in the world. During the last five reported years, the exports of Syria have increased by \$712M from \$554M in 2018 to \$1.27B in 2023.
