Where can I get Internet access in Uruguay?

Internet access via cell phone networks is probably the most vibrant and competitive Internet marketplace in Uruguay. All the Uruguayan cell phone companies (Antel, Claro, Movistar) offer data plans for their smartphone users as well as USB modems for personal computers.

What is the telecommunications market in Uruguay?

Telecommunications market includes three mobile network operators and a competitive fixed-line and pay TV landscape. Telefónica Uruguay is the second-largest mobile operator, operating in a stable and growing market. Mobile market growing approximately 4% annually since 2022, driven by rising postpaid adoption and the region's highest ARPU.
