

# Where can I find outdoor power supply in Slovakia

Do I need a travel adapter in Slovakia?

Slovakia uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C & E (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. Are the electrical outlets and power plugs in your country different? Then you will need a travel adapter.

What is the main source of electricity in Slovakia?

Nuclear power plants are the main source of electricity production in Slovakia. In 2022, over 59 percent of total electricity generation in the country was derived from this source. By comparison, hydroelectric power plants accounted for 13.7 percent of power production, the most of any renewable source.

What is the standard voltage for a power socket in Slovakia?

All power sockets in Slovakia provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Slovakia if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia.

Do North Americans need an adapter in Slovakia?

North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Slovakia. North American device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Slovakia. Also, the voltage in Slovakia is different from North American voltages. Can Europeans use Electronics in Slovakia without an adapter? Yes!

Do I need a voltage converter in Slovakia?

This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia. If the standard voltage in your country is in the range of 100V-127V (which is most common in the US, Canada and countries in South America) you might need a voltage converter in Slovakia. The standard frequency in Slovakia is 50Hz.
